| 1969 | 1. The Wright Brothers fly the first heavier-than-air craft at Kitty Hawk, NC, staying airborne for 90 seconds. |
| 1785 | 2. Travel by supersonic plane, the Concorde, between London and New York now takes 3-1/2 hours. |
| 1939 | 3. The helicopter is invented by Igor Sikorsky. |
| 1913 | 4. The first flight of a U.S. spacecraft carrying an astronaut (Alan Shepard, Jr.) lasts 15 minutes. |
| 1903 | 5. Charles Lindbergh flies from New York to Paris in 33 hours, 29 minutes and 30 seconds, in the first solo non-stop flight across the Atlantic Ocean. |
| 1927 | 6. The first flight of NASA's space shuttle, Columbia. |
| 1961 | 7. Igor Sikorsky develops the first four-engine aircraft. |
| 1976 | 8. Along with her navigator, Fred Noonan, Amelia Earhart, female aviation pioneer, disappears over Howland Island in her attempt to be the first to pilot a plane around the globe. |
| 1937 | 9. Jean-Pierre Blanchard, a French air pioneer, makes the first balloon flight across the English Channel. |
| 1981 | 10. Neil Armstrong and the crew of Apollo 11 make the first manned lunar landing. |
| 1911 | 11. Harriet Quimby becomes the first American female licensed pilot. |
